

MIDLAND AVIATION CAMP



The Midland Aviation is a week long day camp held at the Ormond Barstow Aviation Education Center at the Jack Barstow Airport. It is held in June for young people going into the 9th through 12th grades.



The Camp is a general overview of the aviation and space world. There are lessons on aerodynamics, history, careers, navigation, aircraft structure, charts, weather plus many others. Many outside speakers come to the Camp to share their aviation expertise with the Campers.



Campers get to view airplanes on the field and talk with their pilots and/or builders. A field trip is taken to the Saginaw MBS Airport. The Camp culminates on Saturday with a planned flight with a licensed pilot at which time the Camper will use his/her flight plan and navigation charts to complete the trip.



There is a tuition for the Camp; all of the leaders are volunteers so funds are spent on the Campers. In addition to the adult leaders there are former Campers who have returned as student leaders.
