**The EAA Young Eagles program was launched in 1992 to give interested young people, ages 8 – 17, an opportunity to learn about and fly in a general aviation airplane. These flights are offered free of charge and are made possible through the generosity of our EAA member volunteers.**



**Worldwide since 1992 more than 1.3 million Young Eagles have enjoyed a flight this way. Young Eagles have been flown in more than 90 different countries flown by nearly 40,000 volunteer pilots.**



**Our local Midland Young Eagles flights are held the second Saturday of the month (weather permitting) at the Midland Jack Barstow Airport from 9 AM – Noon. A parent or guardian must sign a permission form before a young person can go on a flight.**
